There are publications in national or international journals that are recognized and the applicant's name must be the first name in at least 2 articles and have other qualifications as announced by the university or the curriculum committee considers appropriate for admission.

Form 2.1 is a study plan that emphasizes research by doing a high-quality thesis that creates academic and professional advancement, including the study of additional subjects. Applicants must have the following qualifications:

A master's degree or equivalent in performing arts or other related subjects Or at the discretion of the Curriculum Management Committee

All applicants for all types of study must have English language skills according to the regulations of Suan Sunandha Rajabhat University on the Basic English Proficiency Test for Doctoral Degree Students 2017 and have other qualifications as announced by the University or the Curriculum Management Committee considers appropriate for admission.
